NRC STAFF CERTIFICATION OF
LICENSING SUPPORT NETWORK SUPPLEMENTATION

By Order, dated July 2005, as modified by Orders dated February 9, 2006 and July 6, 2007,¹ the Pre-License Application Presiding Officer (PAPO) Board required that after a Licensing Support Network (LSN) participant's initial certification of its LSN collection, and after the Department of Energy (DOE) certifies its LSN document collection, each LSN participant shall, on or before the first of each month, certify on a monthly basis that it has duly supplemented its LSN collection with any additional documentary material discovered or created after the time of its initial certification. The jurisdiction of the PAPO Board was terminated on June 5, 2009. Sixth Case Management Order (Regarding State of Nevada's Access to Classified Information, dated June 5, 2009 (unpublished), at 12. However, the continuing monthly certification requirement remains effective. See CAB Case Management Order #1,

dated January 29, 2009 (unpublished), at 2; 10 C.F.R. § 2.1003(e). The NRC Staff last filed a certification of monthly supplementation on May 28, 2010.

On February 16, 2010, the Board issued an order that stayed this proceeding, but did not affect actions the Board may take in the future with respect to preserving and archiving LSN document collections. Order (Granting Stay of Proceeding), dated February 16, 2010 (unpublished). The Stay Order did not specifically relieve parties and governmental participants of their LSN certification requirements. Accordingly, appended to this filing is the June 30, 2010 certification of Ms. Alicia J. Mullins, the official responsible for the administration of the Staff's efforts to identify and make available supplementary documentary material via the LSN.

Also, pursuant to 10 C.F.R. § 2.705(g), and the Pre-License Application Presiding Officer (PAPO) Board's Revised Second Case Management Order, dated July 6, 2007 (unpublished), Fourth Case Management Order, dated October 5, 2007 (unpublished), and Fifth Case Management Order, dated November 1, 2007 (unpublished), as adopted by Case Management Order #1, dated January 29, 2009 (unpublished), at 2, and amended by Order (Addressing the NRC Staff's Motion for Leave to Amend Privilege Log Certification), dated November 18, 2009 (unpublished), the Staff hereby files its supplement to its Deliberative Process Privilege Log.

For these supplements, I hereby certify, to the best of my knowledge, information and belief, formed after reasonable inquiry, that the information on the privilege logs and the claimed privilege for the document is, *inter alia*, correct and consistent with the requirements of the Second Case Management Order.
