This letter serves as a request from Alpha-Omega Services, Inc. (AOS) for an extension of the expiration date of the Authorization for Limited Shipments for the AOS 5979 package, issued February 26, 2009, due to delays in the Safety Analysis Report (SAR) approval process.

AOS currently operates a fleet, consisting of two packages, Serial Numbers AOS I and AOS II/IIIA, for the transportation of Cobalt 60 (CO-60) Special Form sources for use in medical applications under this Special Permit. AOS 5979 Packages are operated and maintained under AOS Quality Program PR9000, approved by the NRC under Docket No. 71-0086 with an expiration date of July 31, 2019.

Alpha-Omega Services, Inc. requests that the NRC extend the Authorization for Limited Shipments from October 31, 2010 to October 4, 2011. A similar request has been sent to the DOT.
