### Dear Administrative Judges:

In its Initial Scheduling Order dated May 19, 2010, the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board ("Board") directed the NRC staff ("Staff") to submit monthly a "short report specifying its best estimates of the dates when it expects to issue the draft and final version of the EIS, and the dates it expects to issue the SER, including any 'advance' SER, SER with open items, and its final SER." The Board specified that the first report is to be submitted on June 3, 2010, and shall be updated on the first Thursday of each month thereafter.

In accordance with the Board's direction, the Staff reports that it will issue the draft environmental impact statement (EIS) in July 2010, the final EIS in February 2011, and the final safety evaluation report (SER) in August 2010. Staff does not anticipate issuing an "advance SER" except to the extent necessary to provide AES with an opportunity to conduct a review for sensitive information; such review would occur in the July/August 2010 timeframe. Staff also does not anticipate issuance of an SER with open items.

The Staff will submit the next status report on Thursday, August 5, 2010.
