ROCKVILLE, MARYLAND (OPEN TO PUBLIC ATTENDANCE)

The Commission was briefed by the NRC staff, State representatives, and stakeholders representing industry and the public on blending of low level radioactive waste.

The staff should determine the resource and schedule impact of completing separate rulemakings on depleted uranium and blending, including pros and cons of such action, and report back to the Commission.

As a separate task, the staff should provide the Commission with the staff's approach to initiate activities related to a risk-informed, performance-based comprehensive revision to Part 61, including the resources and the timeline for completing the rulemaking.

The staff should informally provide the Commission, through a TA brief, additional information on the kinds of site-specific inadvertent intruder analyses that would be required, including how they would be done, and any difficulties licensees may encounter.
