Federal Radiological Monitoring and Assessment Center (FRMAC) Facility Agreement

Federal Radiological Monitoring and Assessment Center (FRMAC) Facility Agreement

THIS AGREEMENT is entered into this 27th day of May 2010, by and between the Wilkes-Barre Scranton International Airport Bi-County Board of Commissioners (Airport), the Luzerne County Emergency Management Agency, the Lackawanna County Emergency Management Agency and the Pennsylvania Emergency Management Agency (PEMA), to provide the terms and conditions under which the Airport agrees to make facilities available to support the Federal Radiological Monitoring and Assessment Center (FRMAC), in the event that the FRMAC should be activated in response to a nuclear power plant incident at either the Susquehanna Steam Electric Station or the Bell Bend Nuclear Power Plant.

1. The Airport will make the following facilities available for at least 90 days:
 - a. One hangar which is approximately 10,000 square feet of space.
 - b. Outside equipment staging area of approximately 15,000 square feet located inside the fenced perimeter of the airport, but not necessarily contiguous to the hangar provided.
 - c. Parking spaces for approximately 100 vehicles located within a short walk from the hangar.
2. In the event that FRMAC is activated and these facilities are actually used for the FRMAC function, security for the FRMAC facility and the access to the airport property for the FRMAC will be the responsibility of the Luzerne County Emergency Management Agency.
3. In the event that FRMAC is activated and these facilities are actually used for the FRMAC function, the facility will be restored to its pre-emergency condition when the FRMAC leaves the facility.

Any of the parties may cancel this agreement within 60 days written notice to the other parties.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, this Agreement is duly executed by the parties hereto as of the day and year first above written, intending themselves to be legally bound hereby.
