

Welcome to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission's Open House for the Public Scoping Meeting Related to the Turkey Point Units 6 and 7 Nuclear Power Plant Combined License Application

This open house is intended to provide an opportunity for interested members of the public and staff from other Federal, Tribal, State, local and other agencies to interact with the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) and the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (Corps), Jacksonville District, staffs in an informal information exchange. The NRC is gathering information necessary to prepare an environmental impact statement (EIS) as part of its review for the proposed combined license (COL) for the Turkey Point, Units 6 and 7 (Turkey Point) site located in Miami-Dade County, Florida.

If you wish to provide formal comments regarding the scope of the environmental review for the Turkey Point COL, they must be provided by **August 16, 2010**. Comments received after this date will be considered if it is practical to do so, but the NRC staff is able to assure consideration only for comments received on or before August 16, 2010.
