This refers to the inspection conducted on June 23, 2010, in Twin Falls, Idaho, and on June 24, 2010, in Ketchum, Idaho. The inspection was an examination of activities conducted under your NRC materials license as they relate to safety and security, and compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations and with the conditions of the license. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selected examination of procedures and representative records, observations of activities, and interviews with personnel. Preliminary inspection findings were discussed with Mr. Mark Lopshire and Dr. Rod Wimmer at the conclusion of the onsite portion of the inspection. A final exit briefing was conducted with you on July 7, 2010.

Within the scope of the inspection, no violations or deviations were identified. Therefore, no response to this letter or the enclosed NRC form 591M is required.
