RE: Agreement Regarding Mandatory Disclosure Schedule for Contention 15

Dear Administrative Judges:

The purpose of this letter is to inform you of an agreement among The Detroit Edison Company, the Intervenors, and the NRC Staff regarding the timing of the mandatory disclosures for Contention 15. In LBP-10-09, dated June 15, 2010, the Licensing Board admitted Contention 15. Under 10 C.F.R. § 2.336, the parties would be required to make initial disclosures related to Contention 15 within 30 days (by July 15, 2010). Following discussions among themselves, the parties now agree that the initial disclosures related to Contention 15 will be due by September 1, 2010. Using the 1st of the month also has the advantage of aligning the disclosure due dates for Contention 15 with that of the other contentions going forward.
