The purpose of this letter is to transmit the revision to our SNM-362 license renewal application. As discussed in previous telephone conversations between you and the NIST Gaithersburg Radiation Safety Officer, Mr. Thomas O'Brien, NIST intends for this submission to replace the previous renewal application in its entirety. Mr. O'Brien has provided you with an electronic copy of the revision highlighting the areas where significant changes to the previous renewal application were made. These include changes related to organizational structure, the addition of radionuclides, and some re-formatting to more closely follow the outline provided in NUREG 1556, Volume 11.

We are also enclosing our updated Decontamination and Decommissioning Cost Estimate, dated April 2010, and our response to the Request for Additional Information (RAI) identified in your February 18, 2010 email to Mr. O'Brien concerning the NIST Decommissioning Funding Analysis. Finally, as requested in your March 15, 2010 email to Mr. O'Brien, NIST discussed its response to the RAI with the NRC's decommissioning cost estimate and financial assurance expert, Mr. Kenneth Kline.
