In Reference 2, the NRC requested additional information to support the review of a certain portion of the Fermi 3 Combined License Application (COLA). The Requests for Additional Information (RAIs) concerned the "ESBWR Steam Turbine – Low Pressure Rotor Missile Generation Probability Analysis" submitted by General Electric Hitachi (GEH) to the NRC in Reference 3. This analysis was referenced in the Fermi 3 COLA.

GEH will be providing an update to the "ESBWR Steam Turbine – Low Pressure Rotor Missile Generation Probability Analysis" to the NRC to address these RAIs as early as August 13, 2010, but no later than September 30, 2010. Subsequently, Detroit Edison intends to complete its response to Reference 2 within 14 days of the GEH submittal of the updated analysis.
