MEMORDANDUM

On June 24, 2010, the Board invited parties to submit their views on whether "the Board should now proceed to resolve Contention 1 through motions for summary disposition, an evidentiary hearing, or some combination of those procedures." The Board acknowledges receipt of the parties' responses.

None of the parties appear to prefer the establishment of an early briefing schedule for motions for summary disposition regarding Contention 1 at this time. However, Calvert Cliffs 3 Nuclear Project, LLC, and UniStar Nuclear Operating Services, LLC (Applicants) mentioned that "[a]dditional updated information is scheduled to be filed on the licensing docket in July or August 2010," and that they "anticipate filing a motion for summary disposition on Contention 1 within 30 days of that submission." Accordingly, the Board will not take further action at this time regarding a briefing schedule for motions for summary disposition or an evidentiary hearing
