## Next Steps for the EP Rulemaking

- Complete incorporation of Comments into Final Proposed Rule
- Get NRC Management Concurrence (Division/Office/Executive Director of Operations)
- Present to Advisory Committee on Reactor Safeguards (ACRS) Subcommittee
- Present to Full ACRS
- ACRS recommendations considered; sent to Commission for final determination
- Commission directs Final Rule Language
- Published in the Federal Register

## Navigating the process

- **Oct. 2010** Final proposed version sent to the ACRS subcommittee & **made public**
- **December 2010-** Full Committee ACRS briefing
- **Late Feb. 2011** Final proposed version sent to the Commission
- **????? 2011** Commission decision (Final Rule) **anticipated**

## What NRC is planning

- **Oct/Nov 2010** - Engage Stakeholders on Implementation Plan
- **April 2011** - Joint NRC/FEMA briefing of implementation plan at NREP
- **June 2011** - Joint NRC/FEMA briefing of implementation plan at NEI EP Forum
- **Summer 2011** - Release documents on Regulations.gov; update Website
- **Summer 2011** - Series of Workshops on Implementation to be conducted nationwide

## Changes to Licensee E Plans

- **RIS 2005-02, Revision 1 (late August 2010)**
- Change evaluated by licensee under 10 CFR 50.54(q) as a Decrease in Effectiveness (DIE)
  - Submitted for NRC prior approval under the NRR Licensing Amendment Process (per 10 CFR 50.90)
- Change evaluated by licensee under 10 CFR 50.54(q) as NOT constituting a DIE
  - May be implemented by NRC without prior NRC approval



## Changes to Licensee EALs

- Adoption of EAL scheme change (in its entirety)
  - Submitted for NRC approval under Appendix E (per 10 CFR 50.4)
- NRC staff will determine whether changes to proposed EAL methodology (e.g., NEI 99-01) constitute a different scheme
  - To be documented in endorsing document (e.g., RIS)

## Changes to Licensee EALs (Cont'd)

- Adoption of specific EAL changes (NOT scheme in its entirety)
  - Change evaluated by licensee under 10 CFR 50.54(q) as NOT constituting a DIE
    - May be implemented by NRC without prior NRC approval
  - Change evaluated by licensee under 10 CFR 50.54(q) as constituting a DIE
    - Submitted for NRC prior approval under the NRR Licensing Amendment Process (per 10 CFR 50.90)

## License Amendment Process (10 CFR 50.90)

- WHY?
  - Public process: Part of NRC openness goal
  - Allows for State consultation
- June 2, 2010 License Amendment Workshop
  - Meeting Summary (ADAMS ML101740174)
- Proposed workshop on RIS 2005-02, Rev. 1
  - Tentatively 4<sup>th</sup> Qtr. Calendar Year 2010
