This is a courtesy notification to let you know that NRC License 25-27524-01 issued to Pioneer Technical Services will expire on December 31, 2010. You will need to submit a license renewal application to keep your license active. There are no fees associated with submitting a license renewal application. We kindly ask you to submit a renewal application as soon as possible to allow a timely processing of the renewed license. Below are the instructions on how to submit the renewal application.

1. Complete NRC Form 313 (see attachment). Have a manager or company owner/principal sign and date the form.

2. Complete Appendix B of NUREG-1556, Volume 1, revision 1, following the instructions provided in this guidance document (see attached).

3. Provide copy of your portable gauge inventory containing at least this information: gauge manufacturer's name, model number, radioactive material and activity (this information is located in the gauge plate). If you have any gauges containing Ra-226 sealed sources please include these in the inventory and provide copies of the leak test results for the Radium-226 gauges.

4. Please note that 10 CFR 30.34, Terms and Conditions of Licenses, was revised to enhance the security requirements for portable gauges containing byproduct material. Revised 10 CFR 30.34 now requires that "each portable gauge licensee shall use a minimum of two independent physical controls that form tangible barriers to secure portable gauges from unauthorized removal, whenever portable gauges are not under the control and constant surveillance of the licensee" (i.e., when not in use). Guidance on these security procedures is provided in revised Appendix H of NUREG-1556, Volume 1, rev. 1 (see attachment). Commit to the following language during the renewal application: "We will implement and maintain the "Operating, Emergency, and Security Procedures" described in the errata sheet to Appendix H of NUREG-1556, Volume 1, Revision 1, and provide copies of these procedures to all gauge users and at each job site."
