PURPOSE: Discuss License Renewal Application for Irigaray and Christensen Ranch

BACKGROUND:

The purpose of this meeting was for Uranium One Americas, Inc., parent company of Uranium One USA, Inc., (formally known as Cogema Mining, Inc.) and Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff to discuss the Source Materials License Renewal Application, NRC License SUA-1341. This meeting was publicly announced on NRC's public webpage on June 30, 2010. The meeting started at 10:45 a.m. eastern time in Conference Room T8C5. An opening statement was presented by Ron Linton, NRC. Participants introduced themselves.

The meeting was attended by those listed in the attachment to this meeting report.

DISCUSSION:

The participants discussed the following items:

1. Removal of references to standard operating procedures (SOPs) in the License Renewal Application.

Discussion: NRC staff indicated that a request to remove SOPs in the license would be considered and reviewed as would any request, provided the request is made in writing to the NRC during the License Renewal Application review process.

2. Modification to the renewal application to use H₂SO₄ or HCl in the elution process for pH control.

Discussion: NRC staff indicated that this request would be considered and reviewed, provided the request is made in writing to the NRC during the License Renewal Application review process.

3. Discuss NRC specific needs in regards to meeting the requirements in 10 CFR 40 Appendix A, Criteria 7 & 8, outside of effluent calculation through modeling.

Discussion: NRC and Uranium One discussed this issue at length. NRC indicated that there is no specific method, approach, or model to use to meet the requirements of 10 CFR 40, Appendix A, Criterion 7 and 8. At the end of the discussion there seemed to be a general understanding of the issue raised by NRC staff in an open issue in previous correspondence.

4. Status update and time line for the final Safety Environmental Report (SER) (post submittal of request for additional information (RAI) responses and renewal document page replacements) and the Environmental Assessment.

Discussion: Since Uranium One has not responded to open issues as discussed in NRC correspondence dated February 18, 2010, NRC staff cannot speculate on a timeframe for completing this licensing action. There was a discussion of the status of the Environmental Assessment which has been sent to other agencies for comment. Uranium One commented that its responses to open issues would likely contain page changes to the License Renewal Application.

5. NRC status on path forward on resolving how licensees are to meet the requirements of Appendix A ,Criterion 5(B)5.

Discussion: There was a lengthy discussion of the point of compliance as referenced in Criterion 5(B)5 and how it relates to in situ sites considering there is no tailings impoundment. NRC staff understands this concern and will try to address this concern through a license condition.

6. Involvement with EPA or NRC regarding the evaporation ponds at Irigaray and Christensen with respect to Subpart W.

Discussion: NRC staff indicated there have been very limited discussions of Subpart W issues with EPA at this time.

No licensing decisions were made or agreed to by either party during this meeting.
