Enclosed is Amendment No. 08, terminating your NRC Byproduct Material License No. 24-32439-01, as requested in your letter dated June 14, 2010. Based on our review of the final status survey documentation submitted in support of the request, the staff has determined that you have satisfactorily demonstrated that any residual byproduct material remaining in the facility is below the NRC's unrestricted use dose limits specified in 10 CFR Part 20, Subpart E "Radiological Criteria for License Termination."

An environmental assessment for this action is not required, since this action is categorically excluded under 10 CFR 51.22(c)(14)(vii).
