Enclosed is Amendment No. 05 to your NRC Material License No. 24-32027-01 in accordance with your request. **This Amendment actually is a corrected copy version of the second Amendment No. 03 that was inadvertently issued on June 16, 2009. The corrections included in this amendment are mostly deletions of former authorized physician users and other changes, such as those in Condition No. 15, are printed in bold font.**

I believe that the errors introduced were the result of an incorrect version of your license that was converted when we changed word processing systems. Thank you for bringing these errors to our attention. We deeply regret these errors and any inconvenience they may have caused you.

I noted that your letter received in our offices on March 19, 2010, included the deletion, via "strike-out," of David Edward Marcus, M.D. In checking your previous records carefully, I did not see a specific request to delete Dr. Marcus as an authorized user.

However, I accepted your "strike-out" of his name as a direction to delete his authorization. If this was an error, please contact me immediately at (630) 829-9841 to discuss reinstating his authorization.


