On July 20, 2010, I contacted the licensee regarding their letter, dated July 16, 2010, requesting a second extension to August 16, 2010.

At 1215, I spoke with Mr. Casey, who described the circumstances related to the request for a second extension. Mr. Casey explained that he was working on two independent high priority actions that are due to the NRC by July 23, 2010 in addition to the subject deficiency letter. I explained the importance of a timely submittal of the required information, which was requested in the deficiency letter, in order to assure timely issuance of the required license. Mr. Casey stated that he understood the importance of a timely submittal of information and resolution to the RAIs. I asked Mr. Casey if an extension to July 30, 2010 could be achieved and he stated that he should be able to meet this date. I asked Mr. Casey if the RSO could send the response directly to the NRC. He stated that TVA has a policy in which all correspondence to the NRC must first be sent to and reviewed by Nuclear Licensing.

At 1630, I also spoke with Mr. Rye Krich, Vice President Nuclear Licensing. I explained the importance of a timely submittal of the required information, which was requested in the deficiency letter, in order to assure timely issuance of the required license. Mr. Krich stated that he understood the importance of a timely submittal of information and resolution to the RAIs. Mr. Krich also explained the circumstances related to the appeal for a second extension. I also asked Mr. Krich if an extension to July 30, 2010 could be achieved. Mr. Krich was appreciative of the extension to July 30, 2010 and stated that they should be able to submit the response to the RAIs by that date.

I stated that a formal letter granting an extension to July 30, 2010 will be drafted and issued on July 21, 2010.

**Action Required: Issue formal reply to request for extension. Maintain frequent contact with the licensee regarding response to RAIs. Complete license renewal upon receipt of response to RAIs.**
