**In preparing this amendment I noticed that Amendment No. 62 had an error in Subitem No. 3, where the date of your letter appeared as "April 12, 2009" instead of "August 12, 2009," which was correct. Condition No. 18.B. was correct in listing the "August 12, 2009" date. Therefore a corrected copy of this amendment is not necessary.**

**However, I wanted to document the error to keep the record of your amendments as correct as possible and to account for any errors. I regret the error and apologize for any inconvenience it may have caused you.**

**At this time I added Condition No. 13.F. to your license, which serves to complete this Condition and enhance awareness of your radiation safety program elements.**

You will be periodically inspected by NRC. Failure to conduct your program in accordance with NRC regulations, license conditions, and representations made in your license application and supplemental correspondence with NRC will result in enforcement action against you. This could include issuance of a notice of violation, or imposition of a civil penalty, or an order suspending, modifying or revoking your

license as specified in the General Statement of Policy and Procedure for NRC Enforcement Actions. Since serious consequences to employees and the public can result from failure to comply with NRC requirements, prompt and vigorous enforcement action will be taken when dealing with licensees who do not achieve the necessary meticulous attention to detail and the high standard of compliance which NRC expects of its licensees.
