SUBJECT: SUMMARY OF JUNE 14, 2010, PUBLIC MEETING WITH PSEG
POWER, LLC, AND PSEG NUCLEAR, LLC (PSEG) ON OVERVIEW OF
PSEG SITE EARLY SITE PERMIT APPLICATION

On June 14, 2010, a Category 1 Public meeting was held between the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff and representatives of PSEG Power, LLC, and PSEG Nuclear, LLC (PSEG). The meeting was held at the NRC Executive Boulevard Building, 6003 Executive Boulevard, Rockville, MD 20852. The purpose of this meeting was for PSEG to provide to the staff an overview of the Early Site Permit (ESP) application for PSEG Site tendered on May 25, 2010. Enclosure 1 lists the meeting attendees. The meeting notice with the agenda (Enclosure 2) can be found in the Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS), Accession No. ML101470209. The agenda included designated time for public interactions with the staff.

The meeting started at 1:30 p.m. (Eastern Daylight Savings Time). After the opening remarks and introductions of the attendees, meeting ground rules and logistics were announced. The staff confirmed that members of the public were in attendance in person and also via a conference bridge. The staff then reviewed the agenda items, which did not include discussion of sensitive, proprietary or safeguards information.

PSEG used prepared slides (Enclosure 3) for their presentation. Following an introduction, PSEG provided an overview of the (i) ESP application development steps, including the plant parameter envelope (PPE) approach, (ii) site utilization plan, (iii) significant changes that were made in the environmental report (ER) following the C-3 audit conducted by the staff on April 12 through 14, 2010, (iv) organization and highlights of Chapters 2, 3, 11, 13, 15, and 17 (of the Site Safety Analysis Report (SSAR)), and (v) PSEG's regulatory interactions and stakeholder outreach activities. PSEG also mentioned that they had communicated with Regions II and III Offices of the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) regarding the ESP application.

At the staff's request, PSEG provided general clarification on the Limited Work Authorization (LWA), which was not requested by PSEG in the ESP application. The staff also asked clarifying questions on matters related to wetland delineation, base load and transmission lines, aircraft hazards, chemical transport on the Delaware River, effects of tsunamis, geotechnical borings, emergency response plans and emergency action levels (EALs), nearby airports, dynamic bearing capacity, meteorology, and site security plans. PSEG responded to all inquiries by the staff. However, the staff, expressed concern that further discussions might be needed regarding the use of the Department of Energy (DOE) Standard DOE-STD-3014-96 in SSAR Section 3.5.1.6, "Aircraft Hazards Analysis."

Closer to the end of PSEG's presentation, it was discovered that the conference bridge was inadvertently disconnected; the meeting organizers expressed an apology, and made several attempts to reestablish the bridge, but were unsuccessful. At the conclusion of the formal presentation and interactions between PSEG and the staff, members of the public, present in person, were given an opportunity to interact with the staff. There were no questions or comments from members of the public.

The meeting was officially adjourned at 3:00 p.m. (Eastern Daylight SavingsTime).
