By letter dated November 21, 2009 (Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS) Accession No. ML093280370), Entergy Operations Inc. (Entergy, the licensee), applied for an amendment to the Waterford Steam Electric Station, Unit 3 (Waterford 3) Facility Operating License No. NPF-38. The proposed change would have revised the existing Facility Operating License Physical Protection license condition to require Entergy to fully implement and maintain in effect all provisions of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC)-approved cyber security plan. Additionally, Entergy requested NRC approval of the Waterford 3 Cyber Security Plan and associated implementation schedule in accordance with Section 73.54 of Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* (10 CFR).

Subsequently, by letter dated July 15, 2010 (ADAMS Accession No. ML102000415), Entergy withdrew the amendment request.
