COMBINED LICENSE APPLICATION – SUBMISSIONS 6 AND 7

This letter forwards Submissions 6 (SUNSI version) and 7 (public version) of the North Anna Combined License Application (COLA). The submissions include revisions to Part 1, General and Administrative Information, Part 2, Final Safety Analysis Report, Part 3, Environmental Report, Part 4, Technical Specifications, Part 5, Emergency Plan, Part 7, Departures Report, and Part 10, Tier 1/ITAAC. A new part, Part 11, Enclosures, has been added.

In parallel, revisions to Part 8, Security, are being submitted by two separate letters (Letter Serial Nos. NA3-10-006 and NA3-10-007) dated the same as this letter.

The submissions reflect Dominion's selection of Mitsubishi Heavy Industry's U.S. Advanced Pressurized Water Reactor (US-APWR) technology for North Anna Unit 3, as stated in Dominion's May 18, 2010 letter to NRC (Letter Serial No. NA3-10-010). The revised Part 2 also constitutes Dominion's update to the FSAR required by 10 CFR 50.71(e)(3)(iii). Other than FSAR changes required to comply with 10 CFR 50.71(e)(3)(iii) and the incorporation of certain commitments, Dominion has endeavored to limit COLA changes to those necessary to support the technology change. That objective was achieved by incorporating the US-APWR DCD, Revision 2 by reference and by maximizing standardization with the content of the US-APWR technology's Reference COLA, Revision 1, for Comanche Peak Units 3 and 4. Other changes include updates to financial and organizational information, updates to reflect a three-inch water level increase for Lake Anna, revised off-site receptor distances, a revised Quality Assurance Program Description, and updated Nuclear Energy Institute templates. A summary of the changes is provided in the form of a revision summary for each affected part.

Enclosure 1 consists of two DVDs containing Submission 6. Each is conspicuously marked with "Withhold from Public Disclosure under 10 CFR 2.390" because proprietary information is contained in Parts 1 and 3, and security-related sensitive information (SRI) is contained in Parts 2 and 3. The proprietary information in Parts 1 and 3 should be withheld from public disclosure in accordance with 10 CFR 2.390(a)(4). Affidavits providing the justification for treating the information as proprietary are provided as Enclosure 3. In

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accordance with NRC Regulatory Issue Summary 2005-26, an affidavit to support withholding of SRI is not required.

A second set of DVDs containing Submission 7 is provided as Enclosure 2. These DVDs contain a public version of the COLA.

Dominion has performed the preflight checks and examined the PDF files contained on the DVDs to ensure conformance with NRC guidelines related to electronic submittals, *Guidance for Electronic Submissions to the NRC*, Revision 5, dated June 25, 2009. The results of the preflight checks are discussed in Enclosure 4.

Results of Preflight Checks for Electronic Submittals

Dominion performed the preflight checks and examined the PDF files contained on the DVDs to ensure conformance with NRC guidelines related to electronic submittals, *Guidance for Electronic Submissions to the NRC*, Revision 6, dated May 17, 2010. The PDF files meet NRC criteria with the exceptions described below.

For electronic submittals, the NRC acceptance criterion for raster image minimum resolution in submission documents focuses on scanned documents and pictorial images, with an objective of precluding diminished document value from low quality images.

- COLA Part 1, Attachments A, C and D include figures that do not meet the minimum resolution criterion. These documents are federal regulatory filings and cannot be altered.
- The Fast Web View for COLA Part 1, Attachments B and D, is not enabled. These documents are federal regulatory filings and cannot be altered.
- COLA Part 3 Figures 5.8-2 and 5.8-3 are photographs (composite artist renderings) that portray the completed facility and as such, do not meet the minimum resolution criterion.
- COLA Part 5 Figures I-1 and II-5 were produced directly from original electronic artwork (not scanned) and are primarily vector graphics that include supporting graphic elements (to distinctly portray secondary roads) that do not meet the minimum resolution criterion. However, the practical effect of meeting the NRC guidelines for scanned images in this instance would result in an overall reduction in the quality of the figures.

Dominion requests that an exception be granted for these electronic submittals for the reasons stated above.
