Dear Administrative Judges:

I write to apprise you of a situation which occurred during our most recent filing and to make several requests. As you know, Dominion-Virginia Power's representative sent to us and to other parties in the above matter physical copies of their revised application on digital disk: North Anna 3 COLA Submission DVD. However, the DVD sent to Blue Ridge Environmental Defense League was delivered to our office in our absence and was left outdoors. We informed David Lewis and Robert Weisman of the fact that we had not received the disk on July 21st and subsequently alerted them to our discovery of the disk on July 22nd.

Apparently, the disk was damaged or is in some way defective because it caused severe computer problems when we attempted to read it, including a series of blank screens and shut downs of our PDF software. Ultimately, we were forced to resort to a back-up computer which was not linked to our main computer, creating a bottleneck for the transfer of data from one computer to the other. We worked until late Friday night. The delayed DVD, the time-consuming computer work-arounds and software reboots caused a critical set back in our ability to file our reply to the Board's order of July 13th. We did submit our reply, but because of the difficulties we encountered, it was not filed until eleven minutes after the midnight July 23rd deadline.

We still do not have an adequate record of the revised North Anna 3 COL application. Therefore, we respectfully request that we be sent a new copy of the North Anna 3 COLA Submission DVD. Further, we request that the board accept the Intervenor's Response of July 23rd as timely filed. Finally, after we have received the requisite legal document and are certain we have the complete record we request additional time to review it in concert with our technical advisors and submit further response.
