STANDARD OPERATING PROCEDURES

Radioactive Materials Ordering and Receipt

SOP RP#6.70

1. Upon ordering radioactive materials (RAM), the ordering personnel will fill out a line item in the Radioactive Materials Order/Receipt Log located in the Radiology S drive: S:\NucOrder
2. The order log will include the date and time of the order, the name of the person ordering, what radioactive material(s) was/were ordered, the quantity, the vendor, the date the package is to be delivered, the shipping contractor, and a package tracking number (if available).
3. A separate information sheet included with the Radioactive Materials Order/Receipt Log will list vendors and shippers, along with 24 hr contact telephone numbers. This information sheet will also include contact information for the NCOIC, Nuclear Medicine and the Radiation Safety Officer.
4. An On-Call Nuclear Medicine Technician (OCNMT) duty roster will ensure 24 hrs a day, 7 days a week availability.
5. The OCNMT on duty will ensure he/she knows what RAM packages are expected to be delivered during his/her tour of duty.
6. The AOD is responsible for notifying the OCNMT when a RAM package arrives at WRAMC, per SOP RP#6.60 (Memorandum posted in AOD binder).
7. If a RAM package is not delivered as expected (i.e., no delivery notification call from the AOD is received), the on-call tech is responsible for notifying the NCOIC, Nuclear Medicine, and the Radiation Safety Officer, as soon it is recognized that the RAM package was not delivered as expected. He/she will then attempt to determine the disposition of the package using the information available in the Radioactive Materials Order/Receipt Log and the associated contact sheet.
8. When a RAM package arrives, the receiving Nuclear Medicine Technician will enter the date and time of receipt in the Radioactive Materials Order/Receipt Log, and then follow the RAM package receipt procedures as directed in SOP RP#6.00, Receipt of Radioactive Materials.
