
The purpose of this letter is to provide the Tennessee Valley Authority's (TVA's)

In accordance with the referenced letter, the NRC requested TVA's plan and timetable for completion of the decommissioning activities for this license. After reviewing the current status regarding this license, TVA has resolved the issue that led to abandonment of the previous termination request. TVA will submit an application for termination by October 1, 2010. This application will supersede the licensing action abandoned on April 8, 2008. The application will incorporate the previous written request for additional information and the additional information previously requested by phone.
