SUBJECT: CLOSURE OF INVESTIGATION (OI 4-2009-051)

Dear Mr. McCann:

This refers to an investigation conducted by the NRC Office of Investigations (OI) regarding activities at River Bend Station. OI initiated the investigation to determine whether a radiation protection technician formerly employed by Entergy at River Bend Station (RBS), St. Francisville, Louisiana was the subject of continued employment discrimination for bringing forward safety concerns.

Based on the evidence developed during the investigation, testimony, and document reviews, the alleged discrimination was determined not to be substantiated. The NRC plans no further actions related to the discrimination aspect of this allegation and considers this investigation closed.
