Pursuant to the California Code of Regulations, Division 1, Title 17, Chapter 5, Subchapter 4, Group 2, Licensing of Radioactive Material, and in reliance on statements and representations heretofore made by the licensee, a license is hereby issued authorizing the licensee to receive, use, possess, transfer, or dispose of radioactive material listed below; and to use such radioactive material for the purpose(s) and at the place(s) designated below. This license is subject to all applicable rules, regulations, and orders of the California Department of Public Health now or hereafter in effect and to any standard or specific condition specified in this license.

LICENSE CONDITIONS

10. Radioactive material shall be stored only at and distributed from the following location only:
- (a) 4860 Linda Vista Avenue, Napa, CA.
11. This license is subject to an annual fee for sources of radioactive material authorized to be possessed at any one time as specified in Items 6, 7, 8 and 9 of this license. The annual fee for this license is required by and computed in accordance with Title 17, California Code of Regulations, Sections 30230-30232 and is also subject to an annual cost-of-living adjustment pursuant to Section 100425 of the California Health and Safety Code.
12. Radioactive material shall be used by, or under the supervision of, the following individuals:
- (a) Leif Vasstrom
13. Except as specifically provided otherwise by this license, the licensee shall possess and use radioactive material described in Items 6, 7, 8 and 9 of this license in accordance with the statements, representations, and procedures contained in the documents listed below. The Department's regulations shall govern unless the statements, representations, and procedures in the licensee's application and correspondence are more restrictive than the regulations.
- (a) The application dated September 10, 2007 signed by Leif Vasstrom, Radiation Safety Officer, with attachments thereto, as modified by the letters with attachments, dated September 11, 2007, all signed by Leif Vasstrom.
- (b) The letter dated September 9, 2009, and the letters dated November 30, 2009, and December 24, 2009, all signed by Leif Vasstrom, Principal and Owner, regarding addition of 3224 Von Uhlit Ranch Road, Napa, for storage of radioactive materials and release of 1135-1145 Golden Gate Drive, Unit 12115, Napa, for unrestricted use.

- (c) **The letter dated April 22, 2010, and the letter with attachments, dated July 21, 2010, both signed by Leif Vasstrom, Principal and Owner, regarding addition of 4860 Linda Vista Avenue, Napa, for storage of radioactive materials, and release of 3224 Von Uhlit Ranch Road, Napa, for unrestricted use.**
14. The Radiation Safety Officer in this program shall be Leif Vasstrom.
  15. At least 30 days prior to vacating any address of use listed in Condition 10 of this license, the licensee shall provide written notification thereof to the California Department of Public Health, in accordance with Title 17, California Code of Regulations, Section 30256 (b).
  16. A copy of this license and all records and documents pertaining to this license shall be maintained available for inspection at **4860 Linda Vista Avenue, Napa, CA.**
  17. The licensee will provide the Low Level Radioactive Waste (LLRW) reports specified in the California Health and Safety Code section 115000.1(h) to the California Department of Public Health (CDPH) on an annual basis for both shipped and stored LLRW. Alternatively, LLRW shipment information may be provided on a per shipment basis. LLRW shipment information and annual reports shall be mailed to:
