**MATERIALS LICENSE**

Pursuant to the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended, the Energy Reorganization Act of 1974 (Public Law 93-438), and Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations, Chapter I, Parts 30, 31, 32, 33, 34, 35, 36, 39, 40, and 70, and in reliance on statements and representations heretofore made by the licensee, a license is hereby issued authorizing the licensee to receive, acquire, possess, and transfer byproduct, source, and special nuclear material designated below; to use such material for the purpose(s) and at the place(s) designated below; to deliver or transfer such material to persons authorized to receive it in accordance with the regulations of the applicable Part(s). This license shall be deemed to contain the conditions specified in Section 183 of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended, and is subject to all applicable rules, regulations, and orders of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission now or hereafter in effect and to any conditions specified below.

10. This license does not authorize possession or use of licensed material.
11. The licensee is authorized to distribute only from its facility located at 4860 Linda Vista Avenue, Napa, California.
12. The licensee shall submit periodic material transfer reports as specified in 10 CFR 32.16.
13. In accordance with 10 CFR 30.11(a), the licensee is exempt from the labeling requirements in 10 CFR 32.15(d) for identifying the byproduct material on the 400 Watt lamps distributed provided the lamps are labeled as described in electronic mail dated October 16, 2007, and for the reason described in electronic mail dated October 24, 2007.
