Dear Mr. Krich:

This is an administrative amendment of your license, required in order to establish maximum possession limits in accordance with current NRC policy. Enclosed with this letter is the amended license.

We understand that you do not currently possess materials under this license, to the best of your knowledge. We further understand that you intend to re-submit a request to terminate the license by October 1, 2010, and will provide the additional information requested in our letter dated April 8, 2008 (ADAMS Accession No. ML081060639). Until the license is terminated, you are required to provide financial assurance for the past activities that were performed under this license. An additional administrative item related to the financial assurance for this license was opened and will be transmitted to you in a separate letter.

In addition, your July 23, 2010, letter stated that questions regarding the license should be referred to you, or to Kevin Casey. The current amendment still lists James B. Colagross as the Radiation Safety Officer for this license. If Mr. Colagross is no longer the Radiation Safety Officer and should not be contacted, you must submit an amendment request for approval of a new Radiation Safety Officer.

Please review the enclosed document carefully and be sure that you understand and fully implement all the conditions incorporated into the amended license. If there are any errors or questions, please notify the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Region I Office, Licensing Assistance Team, (610) 337-5239, so that we can provide appropriate corrections and answers.

An environmental assessment for this action is not required, since this action is categorically excluded under 10 CFR 51.22(c)(14).
