By application dated November 16, 2009 (Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS) Accession No. ML093210542), Omaha Public Power District (OPPD, the licensee) requested a license amendment to approve the cyber security plan and implementation schedule, and revise the license condition regarding physical protection to require the licensee to fully implement and maintain in effect all provisions of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC)-approved cyber security plan. By letter dated July 26, 2010 (ADAMS Accession No. ML102080452), OPPD withdrew its application dated November 16, 2009, and submitted a revised request that superseded the letter dated November 16, 2009, in its entirety.

The purpose of this letter is to advise that the above-cited application is being treated as withdrawn. Notice of Consideration of Issuance of the proposed amendment had not been published in the *Federal Register*.
