SUBJECT: SUMMARY OF JULY 22, 2010, CATEGORY 1 PUBLIC
TELECONFERENCE WITH THE FLORIDA POWER AND LIGHT
COMPANY TO DISCUSS ENVIRONMENTAL INFORMATION
NEEDS FOR THE TURKEY POINT UNITS 6 AND 7 COMBINED
LICENSE APPLICATION

On July 22, 2010, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff held a Category 1 public teleconference with the Florida Power and Light Company (FPL) to discuss the status of selected information needs related to the environmental review for the Turkey Point Units 6 and 7 combined license application. Topics covered by the subject information needs included the resource areas of terrestrial ecology, aquatic ecology, socioeconomics, cultural resources, meteorology, and alternatives. In most cases FPL was providing the status of its efforts to provide the staff with access to additional information for review.

Enclosure 1 is the agenda for the meeting. Enclosure 2 lists the meeting attendees.

The participants discussed FPL's use of certain socioeconomic multipliers. FPL had used the multipliers to perform sensitivity analyses regarding the effects of worker income. FPL has determined that these sensitivity analyses are not appropriate or needed and will remove them in a future revision of the environmental report (ER).

The participants discussed FPL's evaluation of traffic impacts. The site certification application that FPL has submitted (and updated) to the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP) contains additional information that FPL is reviewing for inclusion in a future revision of the ER.

Regarding greenhouse gas emissions, FPL is evaluating information it has already submitted to FDEP and other data to determine what information it will be able to provide in a future revision of the ER.

The participants discussed FPL's evaluation of alternative sites. FPL will make available for staff review a study it performed using geographical information systems data. This information was used by FPL in support of its site selection process. FPL is also assessing whether it will develop a theoretical footprint for the units on the alternative sites to aid the staff in its evaluation of the impacts at those sites. However, FPL questions whether such a theoretical footprint is encompassed by the guidance in the NRC staff's Environmental Standard Review

Plan (NUREG-1555). FPL indicated that if such footprints were to be provided, they might not be available until after Revision 2 of the application, currently scheduled for December 2010.

Finally, the participants discussed FPL's evaluation of terrestrial ecology impacts at the proposed and alternative sites. This decision focused on the use in the ER of data from the U.S. Geological Survey (USGS) as compared to the Florida Land Use and Cover Classification System (FLUCCS) data. While the use of USGS data is an acceptable approach, the FLUCCS data is rather more useful for reviewers. FPL indicated that it used FLUCCS data for the proposed site in its site certification application to FDEP, but that it used the USGS data for the ER based on an understanding that this approach was preferred by the NRC staff. FPL also noted that the NRC staff could access the FLUCCS-based information in the site certification application. However, the participants acknowledged that there is no current analysis for the alternative sites that is based on FLUCCS data. The NRC staff asked FPL to determine whether it could provide analysis for the alternative sites with FLUCCS data once a footprint has been established (see previous item).

FPL indicated that it used FLUCCS data for the proposed site in its site certification application to FDEP, but that it used the USGS data for the ER based on an understanding that this was preferred by the NRC staff. The NRC staff could access the FLUCCS-based information in the site certification application. However, there is no current analysis for the alternative sites that is based on FLUCCS data. The NRC staff has asked FPL to determine whether it can provide analysis for the alternative sites with FLUCCS data once a footprint has been established (see previous item).
