To Whom It May Concern:

The Nevada Nuclear Waste Task Force (Task Force) is a non-profit, public advocacy organization seeking openness and transparency, public involvement, government accountability and public access to information regarding government actions and decisions on nuclear waste and related issues. We have closely followed and participated in meetings, workshops and conferences focused on nuclear waste issues for over twenty years.

Pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act (“FOIA”), 55 U.S.C. 552, the Task Force is requesting documents related to the working group meeting of the Used Fuel Disposition Campaign, held on July 28 – 30, 2010 in Las Vegas, NV. The Used Fuel Disposition Campaign is within the Office of Used Nuclear Fuel Disposition Research & Development of the Nuclear Energy Division of the U.S. Department of Energy. We request any documents received or created by NRC staff who attended this meeting including but not limited to handouts, presentations, slides, summaries done, and notes taken at, or related to, the meeting.

We request a fee waiver for these documents on behalf of the Task Force, to the extent the charges exceed the free search time and copies to which the Task Force is entitled. The Task Force is entitled to a fee waiver because this is a noncommercial request whose disclosure is in the public interest and will contribute to a better understanding of the agency’s programs, operations and activities by the general public, and will primarily benefit the public rather than the Task Force.

We look forward to your response within the required 20 day time period.
