The purpose of this letter is to provide updated schedule information for the responses to Request for Additional Information (RAI) 244. RAI 244 addresses Fitness for Duty, as discussed in Section 13.7 of the Final Safety Analysis Report (FSAR), as submitted in Part 2 of the Calvert Cliffs Nuclear Power Plant (CCNPP) Unit 3 Combined License Application (COLA), Revision 6.

The referenced letter anticipated that the responses would be provided by July 30, 2010. UniStar Nuclear Energy requires additional time to finalize the responses to RAI 244, Questions 13.07-1 through 13.07-3. Responses to these questions will be provided to the NRC by August 31, 2010.
