## ORDER (Denying Motion Re: Invite to Lakota Ceremony)

On July 16, 2010, Petitioner Theodore P. Ebert, through his counsel, filed a motion

inviting this Licensing Board and all parties to the above docket to participate in a traditional

Lakota ceremony at a time and date to be determined by the Board.<sup>1</sup> Mr. Ebert is a Petitioner in

the Powertech licensing proceeding but has been denied standing in that case.<sup>2</sup> On July 26,

2010, both Powertech and the NRC Staff filed responses opposing Mr. Ebert's motion.<sup>3</sup>

While the Board appreciates Mr. Ebert's invitation – especially the motivation to bring together people of differing cultures, viewpoints, and positions – we must deny Mr. Ebert's motion. The Board does not believe that convening the parties to participate in a traditional Lakota ceremony will assist in the development of a sound judicial record. Moreover, it would require the Board to act outside of its adjudicatory role. While the ceremony would be both interesting and educational, the Commission's regulations make clear that our role is an

<u>adjudicatory</u> role.<sup>4</sup> The Board, however, appreciates the invitation and the spirit in which it was extended.

The Board will be conducting limited appearance statement sessions in this case in accordance with 10 C.F.R. § 2.315(a). At that time, Mr. Ebert, along with interested members of the public, is welcome to share his thoughts and concerns with the Board.

For the foregoing reasons, Mr. Ebert's motion is denied.

It is so ORDERED.
