This letter serves to provide additional detail on the tasks and schedules associated with the public outreach/education program for two historic resources, Camp Conoy (CT-1312) and the Baltimore and Drum Point Railroad (CT-1295), identified as part of cultural resources studies of the proposed Calvert Cliffs Nuclear Power Plant (CCNPP) Unit 3 project, Calvert County, Maryland. These tasks were originally outlined in the Revised Mitigation Plans for each resource, submitted to the MHT on June 25, 2009.

Camp Conoy

Public Outreach Publication

As part of Camp Conoy mitigation, GAI will produce an illustrated brochure designed for public outreach that portrays the variety of natural and cultural resources at CCNPP. This publication will incorporate historical highlights (as collected during documentary research and oral history interviews), archaeological findings, and descriptions of local flora and fauna. The publication will be targeted to the elementary and middle school grade levels, and will include such themes as native populations, colonial development, the development of democracy and religious tolerance in Maryland, agricultural heritage, commerce and markets, transportation, local ecology, and energy. Both the brochure and the reader-friendly technical report will be made available to the community at local historical societies, libraries, schools, and other public institutions.

Baltimore and Drum Point Railroad

Public Outreach Poster

To maximize the potential benefit for public outreach as it relates to this resource, GAI will prepare a richly illustrated poster for display at local libraries, schools, historical societies, and other public institutions. This poster will provide a narrative text that describes the history of the Baltimore & Drum Point Railroad and its planned role in shaping the economic and infrastructure development in Calvert County in the late nineteenth century. Graphics depicting this railroad will be a primary focus of the poster, and will include: modern photographs resulting from the current study; historic photographs depicting construction activities, if available; historic-period photographs of the study area highlighting important themes in the study area and Calvert County; and mapping (both modern and historic mapping, if available) depicting the planned railroad alignment and the locations of its extant segments. By preparing a display poster, the history of this resource can reach a wide audience for an extended time period.

Schedules

The schedules for the public outreach/education tasks for these resources are attached to this letter. GAI and UniStar anticipate that the public outreach task for the Baltimore and Drum Point Railroad will commence in April 2010 and conclude by June 11, 2010. The public outreach task for Camp Conoy is expected to commence in May 2011 and conclude by August 31, 2011.
