NRC ASSIGNS NEW SENIOR RESIDENT INSPECTOR AT R.E. GINNA NUCLEAR PLANT



Nuclear Regulatory Commission officials in King of Prussia, Pa., have assigned Gordon Hunegs as the senior resident inspector at the R.E. Ginna nuclear power plant in Ontario, N.Y. The plant is operated by Constellation Energy.

Each U.S. commercial nuclear power plant has at least two NRC resident inspectors. They serve as the agency's eyes and ears at the facility, conducting regular inspections and monitoring plant operations. The resident inspectors can be assigned to any one site for a total of about seven years.

"Gordon Hunegs has the experience and commitment to safety that will help the NRC ensure that Ginna conducts operations with the highest safety standards to protect the public health and safety," said acting NRC Region I Administrator Marc L. Dapas.

Hunegs joined the NRC's Region II office in Atlanta in 1986 as a project engineer. He has been assigned as a resident inspector at Indian Point 3 in Buchanan, N.Y., and as a senior resident inspector at Indian Point 2, and at FitzPatrick and Nine Mile Point in Scriba, N.Y. Hunegs served in the United States Navy for seven years. He is a graduate of the United States Naval Academy in Annapolis, Md.
