SUBJECT: TURKEY POINT UNITS 6 AND 7 COMBINED LICENSE APPLICATION ONLINE REFERENCE PORTAL

Dear Mr. Maher:

By letter dated June 30, 2009, Florida Power & Light Company (FPL) submitted its application to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) for combined licenses (COLs) for two AP1000 advanced passive pressurized water reactors in accordance with the requirements contained in 10 CFR Part 52, "Licenses, Certifications and Approvals for Nuclear Power Plants." By letter dated September 4, 2009, the NRC informed you that we had docketed your COL application for the Turkey Point Units 6 and 7 in the NRC Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS), Accession No. ML092380248.

To improve the efficiency of the environmental and safety reviews, FPL and the NRC staff discussed the use of an online reference portal that would allow the NRC staff and its contractors, Pacific Northwest National Laboratories and Information Systems Laboratories, Inc. limited read-only access to the basis documents and other reference materials cited in the Turkey Point COL application. The online reference portal would allow the NRC staff to audit basis documents to determine whether the information included in the documents supports the COL application. Documents identified as necessary for analysis of the COL application or development of the environmental impact statement (EIS) will be identified by the NRC staff. FPL will be formally requested to submit those documents on the NRC docket. Use of the online reference portal is acceptable as long as the following conditions are met by FPL:

- The online reference portal will be password-protected and passwords will be assigned to staff directly involved in the COL review on a need-to-know basis;
- The online reference portal will be sufficiently secure to prevent staff from printing, saving, or downloading any documents; and
- Conditions of use of the online reference portal will be displayed on the log-in screen and will require concurrence by each user.

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The conditions associated with the online reference portal must be maintained throughout the duration of the Turkey Point COL application review process. Please provide written confirmation that FPL agrees to the terms and conditions set forth in this letter.
