Dear Sir or Madam:

Request amendment of the referenced by-product materials license to change the designated Radiation Safety Officer. Effective 1 August 2010, Major Harry M. Stewart, Jr. will succeed Mr. Lucious Cooper, Jr. as our radiation safety officer. Major Stewart served as the Radiation Safety Officer on this license from 15 September 2008 until 5 May 2009. A record of his qualification and experience is already on file at your office. This request was approved by the Radiation Safety Committee on 22 July 2010.

Request amendment of the referenced by-product materials license to remove Winn Army Community Hospital (WACH), 1061 Harmon Avenue, Fort Stewart, Georgia (paragraph 10.B) from the license. NRC Regulations no longer require a facility to be under an NRC license for sentinel node biopsy when the quantity of licensed material is less than 100 micro-curies. Sentinel node biopsy is the only purpose for which WACH was added to this NRC license. This request was approved by the Radiation Safety Committee on 22 July 2010.

Request amendment of the referenced by-product materials license to correct an error in the renewal application dated 4 June 2003. The error is in paragraph 9.6 stating room 915, the dedicated in-patient ablation room, is shielded on three sides by lead-lined walls. Room 915 is not a lead-lined room. Other statements pertaining to measures designed to control exposure to other patients and the general public are correct. This request was approved by the Radiation Safety Committee on 22 July 2010.
