Dear Administrative Judges:

The purpose of this letter is to inform you of an agreement among The Detroit Edison Company, the Intervenors, and the NRC Staff regarding the timing of Detroit Edison's next supplement to its disclosures, including the initial disclosures for Contention 15. Those disclosures were scheduled to be complete on September 1, 2010. However, due to technical difficulties associated with electronically stored information ("ESI"), Detroit Edison requested, and the other parties agreed, to modify the due date for Detroit Edison's next supplemental disclosure filing. Detroit Edison will file its next supplement, including the initial disclosures related to Contention 15, on or before September 15, 2010.
