Pursuant to 10 C.F.R. § 2.904, the Board respectfully requests the Commission to designate a representative to advise and assist the Board with respect to security classification of information and safeguards to be observed.

The Board was established to conduct the mandatory hearing on the application of GE-Hitachi Global Laser Enrichment LLC for a license to enrich uranium by a laser-based enrichment process at a facility to be located in New Hanover County, North Carolina. As stated in the Notice of Hearing, the applicant has submitted portions of its application that are classified. See 75 Fed. Reg. 1819, 1826 (Jan. 13, 2010). Accordingly, the Board seeks advice and assistance concerning, among other things, how to address the proposed laser-based

enrichment process as openly and transparently as practicable (<u>see</u> 10 C.F.R. § 2.328), while avoiding disclosure of Restricted Data or National Security Information (<u>see</u> 10 C.F.R. Part 2, Subpart I).
