I am deeply concerned about what I have recently heard (from a public radio interview and Nuclear Information Resources Service, Washington DC) about radioactive metals entering the metals stream through recycling. Apparently The Navy recently noticed radioactive cookware they were about to start using since they had a Geiger counter. I have heard that the NRC and DOE are considering raising dose limits and that a new rule would allow companies to recycle radioactive metal and that this radioactivity could reach consumer products like bed frames for example.
