On behalf of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC), I am responding to your August 12, 2010, letter to Chairman Jaczko regarding the draft revision to NUREG-0654/FEMA-REP-1, Rev. 1, Supplement 3, "Guidance for Protective Action Recommendations for General Emergencies." The NRC worked closely with the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) on the revision to this joint guidance document. The draft document was reviewed by FEMA and approved by the Administrator as a draft for public comment. FEMA staff joined NRC staff in answering public questions during the public meetings. The comments that your staff provided are being reviewed by a joint panel comprised of NRC and FEMA personnel.

Please note that the final version of NUREG/CR-6953, Vol. III, "Review of NUREG-0654, Supplement 3, 'Criteria for Protective Action Recommendations for Severe Accidents. Technical Basis for Protective Action Logic Diagram,'" was posted for public review on the Regulations.gov website under the Supplement 3 docket March 8, 2010, and is now available on the NRC website. We agree with you that implementation of the revised Supplement 3 will have to await the availability of the 2010 census data and the development of new evacuation time estimates for each nuclear plant site.

Thank you for your participation in the public meetings and for taking the time to provide comments on this document.
