In a Memorandum dated July 14, 2010, the Licensing Board addressed the briefing schedule for summary disposition motions regarding Contention 1. The Board noted that the Applicants intended to file additional information related to Contention 1 on the licensing docket in July or August 2010, and that the Applicants anticipate filing a motion for summary disposition on Contention 1 within 30 days of that submission. The Board requested that the Applicants notify the Board if plans change significantly from that described previously.

While the Applicants continue to prepare the submittal with additional information relevant to Contention 1, that effort remains ongoing and the submittal will not be finalized and submitted to the NRC before the end of August. The Applicants do not anticipate a lengthy delay, but will notify the Board and the other parties when the package has been submitted on the docket.
