Industry and NRC will conduct a sequence of public interactions to reach the following goals:

- 1. Industry and NRC reach consensus on whether storage and transportation license/CoC amendments are required for the four variants of SCC-susceptible fuel assemblies listed above.
- 2. In the case(s) where license/CoC amendments are necessary, industry and NRC agree on the technical aspects that must be addressed and the form of a potential bounding generic analysis.
