**SOURCE MATERIAL LICENSE**

Pursuant to the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, and Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations, Chapter 1, Part 40, "Licensing of Source Material," and in reliance on statements and representations heretofore made by the licensee, a license is hereby issued authorizing the licensee to receive, possess and import the source material designated below; to use such material for the purpose(s) and at the place(s) designated below; and to deliver or transfer such material to persons authorized to receive it in accordance with the regulations in said Part. This license shall be deemed to contain the conditions specified in Section 183 of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954 and is subject to all applicable rules, regulations, and orders of the Atomic Energy Commission, now or hereafter in effect, including Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations, Chapter 1, Part 20, "Standards for Protection Against Radiation," and to any conditions specified below.

**CONDITIONS**

8. Authorized use (Unless otherwise specified, the authorized place of use is the licensee's address stated in Item 2 above.) For fabrication of spotting rounds and artillery rounds at Lake City Arsenal, Independence, Missouri, and Frankfort Arsenal, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, and for the testing of these rounds in accordance with the procedures and conditions described in the applications for license submitted by the Ordnance Corps dated May 1, June 2, and September 26, 1961, and the licensee's letter of September 20, 1962. The licensee is further authorized to distribute the artillery and spotting rounds to field units of the Army and to use such rounds for military purposes in accordance with the procedures described in the licensee's applications of September 19, 1961, and September 20, 1962. This license authorizes the export of spotting rounds and artillery rounds for military purposes.
