Pursuant to delegation by the Commission dated December 29, 1972, published in the Federal Register, 37 Fed. Reg. 28,710 (1972), and the Commission's regulations, see 10 C.F.R. §§ 2.104, 2.300, 2.303, 2.309, 2.311, 2.318, and 2.321, notice is hereby given that an Atomic Safety and Licensing Board (Board) is being established to preside over the following proceeding:

(Turkey Point Units 6 and 7)

This proceeding concerns petitions to intervene submitted (1) by the Village of Pinecrest, Florida, (2) by Citizens for Safe Energy, Inc., and (3) jointly by Mark Oncavage, Dan Kipnis, Southern Alliance for Clean Energy, and National Parks Conservation Association. These petitions were submitted in response to a June 18, 2010 Notice of Hearing and Opportunity to Petition for Leave to Intervene (75 Fed. Reg. 34,777). Petitioners challenge the application filed by Florida Power & Light Company pursuant to Subpart C of 10 C.F.R. Part 52 for a combined license for Turkey Point Units 6 and 7, to be located in Homestead, Florida.
