ORDER (Granting Joint Motion for Extension of Time)

On September 2, 2010, the NRC Staff filed a joint motion¹ requesting that the Board extend the deadline for the parties to provide their initial mandatory disclosures and privilege claims² and for the NRC Staff to provide a hearing file.³ Under the Commission's regulations, initial disclosures and the Staff's hearing file must be produced by Tuesday, September 7 – thirty days after the Board issued its memorandum and order granting petitioners' requests for hearing.⁴ In its motion, the Staff explained that an extension was necessary due to the "number of documents it will have to disclose, the difficulty and converting certain documents to formats suitable for inclusion in the hearing file, and the need for Staff to further review potentially

privileged material."⁵ The Staff indicated that Consolidated Intervenors and Powertech join in the Staff's request and that the Oglala Sioux Tribe had not responded to the Staff's proposal at the time of filing.⁶

For good cause shown, the Board hereby grants the joint motion for extension of time.

All initial mandatory disclosures, claims of privilege, and the NRC Staff's hearing file are now due no later than Monday, September 13, 2010.

It is so ORDERED.
