**U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission is
Soliciting Comments on issues to consider for the Preparation of
A Supplemental Environmental Impact Statement
For the Proposed Powertech Inc. Dewey-Burdock Uranium
Recovery Facilities to be Located near Edgemont, South Dakota
in Custer and Fall River Counties**

The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) has received an application from Powertech (USA) (Powertech) to construct and operate the Dewey-Burdock Project in-situ uranium recovery (ISR) facility to be located near Edgemont, South Dakota in Custer and Fall River counties. ISR is a process by which a solution is injected through wells into a uranium-bearing ore in order to oxidize and dissolve the uranium, which is then pumped in solution to the surface. The final product of the proposed Dewey-Burdock Project ISR facilities would be "yellowcake," concentrated uranium in the form of U₃O₈, which would be transferred to another facility for enrichment and eventual processing into fuel for nuclear power reactors.

The NRC has the regulatory authority for licensing and inspecting ISR facilities in the U.S. As a part of its review of the Powertech license application, the NRC is preparing a Supplemental Environmental Impact Statement (SEIS) to analyze the environmental impacts of granting Powertech's license request. In June 2009, the NRC published a Generic Environmental Impact Statement (GEIS), which addresses on a programmatic basis, the potential environmental impacts from the construction, operation, aquifer restoration, and decommissioning of ISR facilities. The NRC will use the GEIS to prepare the Dewey-Burdock Project SEIS, incorporating by reference the relevant sections of the GEIS and supplementing the GEIS evaluations with site-specific analyses as necessary.

Members of the public are encouraged to be involved with the Dewey-Burdock Project SEIS by providing comments for the NRC to consider when determining the scope of the review. The public is also invited in accordance with 10 CFR 51 and 36 CFR 800, the implementing regulation for Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act, to submit comments regarding potential impacts of historic property in the proposed project area. Comments received will enhance the SEIS by ensuring that it includes a range of considerations that take into account the views of the public. Typical comments might relate to topics such as alternatives to the proposed action as well as information that should or should not be considered within the review. Please note Docket No. 40-9075 when submitting comments. Comments will be accepted for a thirty day period, ending on Wednesday, March 3, 2010. Once comments have been reviewed and the environmental analysis is complete, the Draft SEIS will be made available for public comment.
