Dear Chairman Jaczko:

Thank you for the opportunity to provide input on the new regulations regarding physical protection of radioactive by-product materials.

The physical security and safe transport of radioactive materials in Texas is a matter of great importance to all Texans. As such, I find it disconcerting that the public was provided such short notice of this meeting. I only received notice five days prior to the meeting, which I think you will agree is wholly insufficient for concerned citizens to be able to familiarize themselves with the proposed new regulations and their implications, as well as to be able to make plans to travel to Austin to participate in these proceedings.

As a member of the Committees on Public Safety and Environmental Regulation in the Texas House of Representatives, I am particularly interested in the security of transport of radioactive waste through my district. I represent approximately 150,000 residents of Fort Worth in a district that is traversed by two interstate highways and multiple freight rail lines. It is essential that these regulations provide adequate mechanisms to ensure not only the physical security of shipments of radioactive waste, but also the safety of the communities through which those shipments pass. I am particularly concerned that the regulations provide robust coordination and communication with local emergency service providers.
