Monument Valley

- DOE - Coordinate with Carl Holiday on future Monument Valley investigations. Drilling starting this week.
- Status of DOE request that consideration be given to having the work conducted by Ben Stanley and Dine College students be performed under NN AML/UMTRA
 - DOE would provide additional funding to NN AML/UMTRA.
 - Ben and the student are currently under U of A; however, U of A will not be involved in the project beyond this year.
- DOE resolution regarding the area of elevated uranium in soils at the site.

Shiprock

- DOE – Flag new fencing areas in Many Devils Wash and provide an updated map to Levon.
- DOE – Ensure that the Shiprock seep sump and well 1088 are up to date on the GEMS site.
