Gentlemen:

This refers to the inspection conducted by Mr. Claude M. Wiblin of this office, on May 6, 1976, of the activities authorized by NRC Source Material License No. SUB-986, and to the discussion of our findings held by Mr. Wiblin with W. L. Utngage, Technical Center Director, on May 6, 1976.

The inspection was an examination of the activities conducted under the license as they relate to radiation safety and to compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations, and the conditions of the license. The inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews of personnel, independent measurements and observations by the inspector.

Based on the results of this inspection, it appears that certain of your activities were not conducted in full compliance with NRC requirements, as set forth in the Notice of Violation, enclosed herewith. These items of noncompliance have been categorized into the levels as described in the correspondence to you dated December 31, 1974.

This notice is sent to you pursuant to the provisions of Section 2.201 of the NRC "Rules of Practice," Part 2, Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations. Section 2.201 requires you to submit to this office within twenty (20) days of your receipt of this notice, a written statement or explanation in reply including (1) corrective actions which have been taken by you


Please refer to your letter of May 13, 1976, transmitting the findings of your inspection conducted by Mr. Claude M. Wiblin on May 6, 1976.

Corrective action has been taken as follows:

1. The five test pits which were unlocked at the time of the inspection have been equipped with steel covers, locked in place. This required condition has been placed on our inspection schedule and will be policed in the future.
2. The signs bearing the words: "Caution Radioactive Materials" were replaced on all test pits on May 10, 1976. Inspection of the signs has been added to our inspection schedule. Signs will be replaced periodically as required by weathering.
